| BITTER BREXIT - English Pale Ale 5.75% ABV, 7 SRM, 36 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$9.00 | ----- |
| An English Pale Ale that is exclusively hopped with East Kent Goldings hops from England. Very floral on the nose with a clean finish and well balanced with a nice malt backbone derived from English Maris Otter malted barley. | | | | |
| PUBLICAN - Pub Ale 5.1% ABV, 9 SRM, 39 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$8 | ----- |
| Publicans are British pub owners who make sure your glass stays full. Perfect for those late night conversations about politics and the world at large, it will keep your mind sharp and your palate happy. It has a floral nose, the body is malty, and has a crisp finish. | | | | |
| CREAMY McBOATFACE - Dry Hopped Cream Ale 5.6% ABV, 3 SRM, 15 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$9.00 | ----- |
| This light and easy drinking cream ale is dry hopped with Calista. The hops add aroma and flavor, not bitterness. This is your boat beer for the summer. Google Boaty McBoatface if you want the inspiration for this beer's name. | | | | |
| FIRST BLOOD - Hefeweizen w/Blood Orange 5.4% ABV, 3 SRM, 12 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$10 | ----- |
| This refreshingly tart and crisp Bavarian style wheat ale has hints of banana, coriander and clove. We've added blood oranges in the fermenter which rounds out the beer with a subtle citrusy zest on the backend. | | | | |
| PLANET OF THE APRICOTS - Apricot Wheat 5.3% ABV, 4 SRM, 30 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$9.00 | ----- |
| This seasonal wheat beer, brewed with masses of apricots, is sessionable, fruity, and light. It's a great thirst quencher. This beer is named for our head brewer's favorite "best worst movie" of all time, Planet of the Apes. | | | | |
| FEMME PETALE - Honey Hibiscus Saison 6.1% ABV, 5 SRM, 25 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$9.00 | ----- |
| This Saison was originally brewed with the Charleston BREWSTERS, an organization that encourages women to brew at local Charleston breweries, and they did an awesome job. We brewed a Saison and added Hibiscus flowers in the kettle and honey in the fermenter. | | | | |
| SHUT THE BOCK UP! - Weizenbock 6.4% ABV, 12 SRM, 18 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$10 | ----- |
| This Weizenbock is a wheat version of the German-style bock, a much darker beer. With lots of banana aroma, the beer has big bread malt flavors with hints of darker stone fruits that will become more prominent with age. Kinda like liquid banana bread... | | | | |
| TART VADER - Berliner Weisse 5.3% ABV, 3 SRM, 4.5 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$9.00 | ----- |
| Our representation of this classic German wheat beer is kettle soured, and lightly hopped resulting in an acidic lemony tartness. For some added sweetness, add a shot of traditional German syrup - Raspberry or Woodruff (floral vanilla) syrups for an additional 50c. | | | | |
| MAD MONK - Belgian Style IPA 6% ABV, 6 SRM, 54 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$9.00 | ----- |
| Brewed with a traditional Trappist yeast this IPA bridges the gap between an IPA and a Belgian Tripel. It uses citrusy Amarillo and spicy Northern Brewer hops to compliment the underlying fruit flavors developed by the yeast. | | | | |
| BEERD OF ODIN - Norwegian Farmhouse IPA 5.9% ABV, 5 SRM, 38 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$9.00 | ----- |
| This beer is brewed with Norwegian Kveik yeast, a recently unearthed yeast strain that has been used on farms in Norway for generations. It ferments incredibly quickly producing tropical flavors that compliment the Citra and El Dorado hops used in this recipe. | | | | |
| THAT'S WHAT SHE SAID - Hazy Rye IPA 6% ABV, 5 SRM, 70 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$10 | ----- |
| This beer was brewed by the women of Two Blokes and Lee Distributors. \$1 from every pint sold benefits SOS Lowcountry Share Our Suzy. Bursting with hop flavor from Sabro, Simcoe and Amarillo hops, it has restrained bitterness, and some spice on the finish from the Rye malt. | | | | |
| CONE OF UNCERTAINTY - HAZY IPA 7% ABV, 5 SRM, 90 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$12 | ----- |
| Life is full of uncertainty especially during hurricane season. That said, there is nothing uncertain about this hazy IPA. Packed with late additions of Mosaic and Simcoe hops this beer is bursting with mango, pine, and citrus and a clean finish. | | | | |
| WICKED THROAT CHAMAH - New England IPA 7.2% ABV, 7 SRM, 75 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$13 | ----- |
| This juicy New England style IPA is wicked awesome! It's a nice alternative to West Coast IPAs. Dry hopped at the height of fermentation with tons of Citra and Amarillo, this beer is definitely hop forward but has almost no bitterness on the back end. | | | | |
| PROPER FLOCCED - American IPA 6.6% ABV, 6 SRM, 58 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$10 | ----- |
| This West Coast IPA uses an experimental hop called BRU-1 that's bursting with pineapple and stone fruit flavors. Combined with Citra hops in the boil, it's almost like candy in a glass. It's heavily dry hopped giving it a great tropical aroma. | | | | |
| THROAT CHARMER ON NITRO - Double IPA 8% ABV, 5 SRM, 90 IBU | ----- | ----- | ----- | ----- |
| Throat Charmer is an Australian slang term for a beer. After a hot dusty day working in the outback, a throat charmer will sort you out. This American-style Double IPA is loaded with hops and it will charm you from the first swallow. A Citra and Amarillo hop bomb. | | | | |
| MOUSTACHE RYED - Black Rye IPA 7.3% ABV, 30 SRM, 82 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$10 | ----- |
| Black IPAs, are also known as Cascadian Darks. If you like hoppy beers, this is a nice alternative to a traditional IPA. We've added some rye to the grain bill for added interest and it is hopped with Columbus and Chinook. | | | | |
| SPLILT MILK - On Nitro - Milk Stout 5.6% ABV, 35 SRM, 25 IBU | ----- | ----- | 4P - \$11 | ----- |
| This stout has big roasted barley flavor on the front end and balanced sweetness on the backend. Milk stouts contain lactose, a sugar derived from milk, which adds sweetness and body. In the 1900s milk stouts were recommended to expecting and nursing mothers. | | | | |
| KEEP CALM AND SAISON - Brandy Barrel Aged Saison 6% ABV, 4 SRM, 26 IBU | ----- | ----- | C - \$14 | ----- |
| This saison is dry, fruity and peppery with a pale straw-colored haze and billowy head. Saison is French for "season". This farmhouse style of beer was historically brewed in winter when it's cool for fermentation and drunk by farmhands in summer. | | | | |
| SCHWAG - Glasses - \$5, T-shirts - \$20-\$25, Hats - \$22, Tap Handles - \$40, Stainless Steel Growler - \$50, | | | | |
| SNACKS - Popcorn - \$3, New Primal Jerky - sticks \$3, Kettle Chips - \$2, Kids Snacks - \$.50, Soda - \$1 a can. | | | | |
